

SECTION 00 11 13 - ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 Receipt of Bids

- A. Sealed proposals will be received by the Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District (NMWRD) for the project entitled “Holiday Hills/ Le Villa Vaupell Sewer Extension – Phase 1” until 10:00 am on February 8, 2022 at the NMWRD Offices located at 113 Timber Trail Road, Island Lake, IL 60042. The sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately afterward in the NMWRD Office, on the same date. Sealed bids shall be addressed to the Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District, P.O. Box 240, 113 Timber Trail Road, Island Lake, IL, 60042 and shall be labeled “Holiday Hills/ Le Villa Vaupell Sewer Extension – Phase 1.”
- B. Any contract or contracts awarded under this invitation for bids are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA). Neither the State of Illinois nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this invitation for bids or any resulting contract. The procurement will be subject to regulations contained in the Procedures for Issuing Loans from the Water Pollution Control Loan Program (35IAC Part 365), the Davis-Bacon Act (40 USC 276a through 276a-5) as defined by the United States Department of Labor, the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act (30 ILCS 570), the Illinois Works Jobs Program Act Apprenticeship Initiative (30 ILCS 559/20-1), and the “Use of American Iron and Steel” requirements as contained in Section 436 of H.R. 3547, The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014. This procurement is also subject to the loan recipient’s policy regarding the increased use of disadvantaged business enterprises. The loan recipient’s policy requires all bidders to undertake specified affirmative efforts at least sixteen (16) days prior to bid opening. The policy is contained in the specifications. Bidders are also required to comply with the president’s Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in 41 CFR 60-4.

 - 1. 9,450 LF of Sanitary Sewer Throughout the Village of Holiday Hills
 - 2. 3,850 LF of Sanitary Force Main Installation
 - 3. Pavement Patching.
 - 4. Restoration with Seed.

 - 1. Lift Station Wet Well, Valve Vault, and Meter Vault
 - 2. Generator and Control Building
 - 3. Hot-Mix-Asphalt Roadway

1.4 Bonds

- A. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond, bank draft, cashier's check or certified check payable to the order of the Village of Holiday Hills, Illinois in an amount not less than ten (10) percent of the amount of the bid, as a guaranty that the bidder will execute the contract, if it is awarded, in conformity with the bid form.
- B. The successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Completion and Payment Bonds on forms provided in the Specifications and Contract Documents, in an amount equal to 110 and 100 percent of the contract sum, respectively.

1.5 Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference

- A. A Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Tuesday, January 18, 2021 at 10:00 am at the project site, starting at the NMWRD Offices, 420 Timber Trail, Island Lake, Illinois. Bidders/Contractors not attending the Pre-Bid Conference shall have their bids rejected.

1.6 Wage Rates

- A. The contractor shall pay prevailing wages in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act (40 USC 276a through 276a-5) as defined by the U.S. Department of Labor, Local Ordinance and the Illinois Department of Labor Prevailing Wages for McHenry and Lake Counties, whichever is greater.

1.7 Rejection of Bids

- A. The Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District may reserve the right to reject any and/or all bids if it has documented sound business reasons.

1.8 Award of Bid

- A. Final award of bid shall be contingent on the Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District receiving financing from the Water Pollution Control loan Program as administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. Per the IEPA's procedures for Issuing Loans from the Water Pollution Control Loan Program as administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. Per the IEPA's Procedures for Issuing Loans from the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund Part 365.620, Section b, unless all bids are rejected, award shall be made to the low, responsive, responsible bidder after the bid evaluation has been submitted to the IEPA and written notice of IEPA approval has been received by the Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District.
