Declaration of State of Emergency

Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker has issued a proclamation of disaster within Illinois as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In light of the Governor's proclamation, the Standards for declaring a state of emergency for the Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District (the "**District**") as set forth in Section 2(b) of the District's "Ordinance Authorizing Emergency Powers and Procedures in Response to Covid-19" as adopted on March 19, 2020 (the "**Ordinance**") have been satisfied. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, I hereby find that an emergency exists and therefore declare a state of emergency for the District.
