NMWRD CHIEF OPERATOR - TREATMENT

The Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District has an immediate opening for a Chief Operator – Treatment. This is a professional, technical position with supervisory responsibility for operational aspects of the District’s wastewater system, comprised of an extensive collection system and treatment plant. **Applicants should have experience and significant wastewater plant and collection system operational experience and possess an Illinois Class 1 Wastewater Operators license. A high school graduate and a valid driver’s license is required.** Other combinations of education, skills, experience and certification may be considered. Excellent oral and written communication skills are required. Starting Range is \$36.75 to \$43.23 per hour, depending on qualifications and certifications. The District provides excellent benefits, including Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.

Duties encompass all facets of wastewater facility operations, maintenance repairs and supervision on the District’s 2 MGD treatment plant. A minimum of 7 years of experience in wastewater operation and 3 years of progressive supervisory experience is highly desirable.
