Dear Neighbors in Holiday Hills and Le Villa Vaupell:

We continue to progress toward the successful completion of your public sanitary sewer system. The Holiday Hills/Le Villa Vaupell Sewer Extension will benefit the ecology of the entire region. Today we have several important updates to offer you.

**Phase 2B is preparing to begin.** As Phase 1 has been completed for the initial 108 homes and Phase 2 has been completed for another 100 homes, we have secured additional grant funding to continue this project into Phase 2B. The project scope of Phase 2B includes 3,700 lineal feet of sanitary sewer within the Village of Holiday Hills and the remainder of the Le Villa Vaupell subdivision to serve an additional 56 homes (see pink area on attached map).

Since construction will commence soon and your property will be affected at your property line, we are requesting that you have a brief discussion with the Northern Moraine Wastewater Reclamation District's resident engineer to coordinate the sewer stub location at your property line.

We intend to inform residents of construction that will affect any access to their property, so starting our dialogue and providing your contact information will simplify our ability to alert you in advance of construction being performed near your property. For example, you could need to plan to move your cars from your driveway for a short period of time while it's inaccessible. We will attempt to notify residents at least 48 hours in advance of construction near their property, plus we plan to have a District representative on site for most construction activities.

This project will require numerous types of construction equipment to excavate and backfill the pipe that is being installed, therefore access to homes adjacent to construction activities may be limited during normal construction hours, but will be restored at the end of each day. Residents can expect traffic detours, construction noise and dust while the new sewer is being installed. As with all construction projects, the work will be completed as weather conditions permit, but Phase 2B is anticipated to be substantially completed by the Spring of 2026. The contractor plans on working 10-hour days during the work week and on Saturdays to make as much progress as possible to limit impact to residents.

**Private sewer connections and costs.** After Phase 2B is complete and fully operational, residents will receive further information on the steps to connect. Residents have several important factors to consider when preparing to decommission their septic system and connect to the public sewer:

- 1. Homeowners must hire a licensed, insured, and bonded contractor to perform the private sewer lateral installation and properly abandon the private sewage disposal system at their cost, following NMWRD standards and subject to inspection.
- 2. The McHenry County Health Department requires a permit, permit fee, and a site plan of the system components being removed prior to the private septic system being decommissioned.
- 3. Standard construction details are enclosed and available at <a href="www.nmwrd.org">www.nmwrd.org</a>. All proposed sewer laterals shall include the installation of an isolation valve. **Please note the connection of sump pumps to the public sewer is prohibited by law.**

**Connection fees and financing offer.** In addition to your private construction costs, all residents will be responsible for the <u>connection fee</u> that all users in the region pay when their homes are constructed and connected to the public sewer. Future increases to the connection fee are subject to the Consumer Price Index, which will occur on May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Homeowners can either make a lump sum payment for their connection fee or take advantage of the unique financing option described below.

**Lump sum option:** Residents who initially connect to the new sanitary sewer will be treated the same as other new customers connecting to other parts of the NMWRD system and will be charged a connection fee (currently \$11,536.78), plus a one-time \$100 inspection fee.

--or--

**Financing offer:** Each parcel is eligible to finance the connection fee if the parcel is connected within three years of the sewer becoming available to the property. The connection fee will be financed at 4% annual interest over 30 years. The installments will be applied to the monthly bill. Those who finance the connection fee will pay the monthly sewer user fee (2025 rate of \$49.35/month) plus the monthly connection fee installment (approximately \$51.67/month), or a total monthly user bill of approximately \$101.02.

Homeowners will be required to apply for a connection permit from the NMWRD and choose a connection fee option prior to commencing work. Homeowners do not have to connect immediately, but all will be required to connect to the sanitary sewer by December 31, 2038, or when their current private septic system fails, whichever comes first.

## **Sewer Disconnect**


Spears® Sewer Disconnect functions as both cleanout and disconnect device, plus helps prevent sewage backup during hurricanes and floods. Complete unit consists of body and plunger (sold separately - both parts are required for proper use). The plunger can be screwed into the body to block solids waste flow. The plunger should be removed from the body and stored when not in use to prevent accidental closing (i.e., from ground vibration, etc.).



- Connects directly to 4" or 6" SDR-35 (or any ASTM D3034/D2729) PVC Sewer Pipe.
- Easily adapted to 4" or 6" Schedule 40 PVC Drainage Pipe with addition of IPS x Sewer Adapters, Socket x Spigot, Spears® part no. 3729-04013IXS for 4" or 3729-06013IXS for 6".
- User-supplied standpipe can be installed to grade using PVC Sewer Pipe connected to the body branch socket
  and a Sewer Cap to close off (Spears® part no. 4047-040 for 4" or 4047-060 for 6"). Optionally, user-supplied
  Schedule 40 Pipe can be used for standpipe with addition of a Schedule 40 DWV Socket Coupling (Spears®
  part no. P100-040 for 4" or P100-060 for 6") and Cap (Spears® part no. P116-040 for 4" or P116-060 for 6").
- T-handle for Plunger operation can be easily fabricated from user-supplied 1" Schedule 40 Pipe and Tee fitting (Spears® part no. 401-010).

Note - the unit restricts flow by approximately 85%. As a result, the unit must be located in the sewer line where solids are present. Full disconnect is not achieved without solids in the flow.


